Introduction: This project is to be created upon completion of the AP Calculus test. It will count as your 4th Nine-Weeks Final Exam Grade.

Guidelines:

- 1. Find 2 or 3 other people to work with. **Tell me who is in your group.**
- 2. Choose a topic for your video. Tell me which topic your group chooses.
 - a. Create a music video (Song Parody) about a calculus concept or formula(s).
 - b. Present the top ten reasons why you love calculus.
 - c. Come up with a list of "Dos" and "Don'ts" for next year's calculus class.
- 3. Your video must be a **minimum** of 3 minutes.
- 4. Your video must be appropriate. No questionable language, gestures, etc.
- 5. Everyone in the group must be in the video.
- 6. Your video must be uploaded to YouTube. Once it is completed, email me the link to the video.
- 7. Your video will be graded on originality, content, participation, quality, and following directions.
- 8. We will watch the videos in class on the last couple of days of school.
